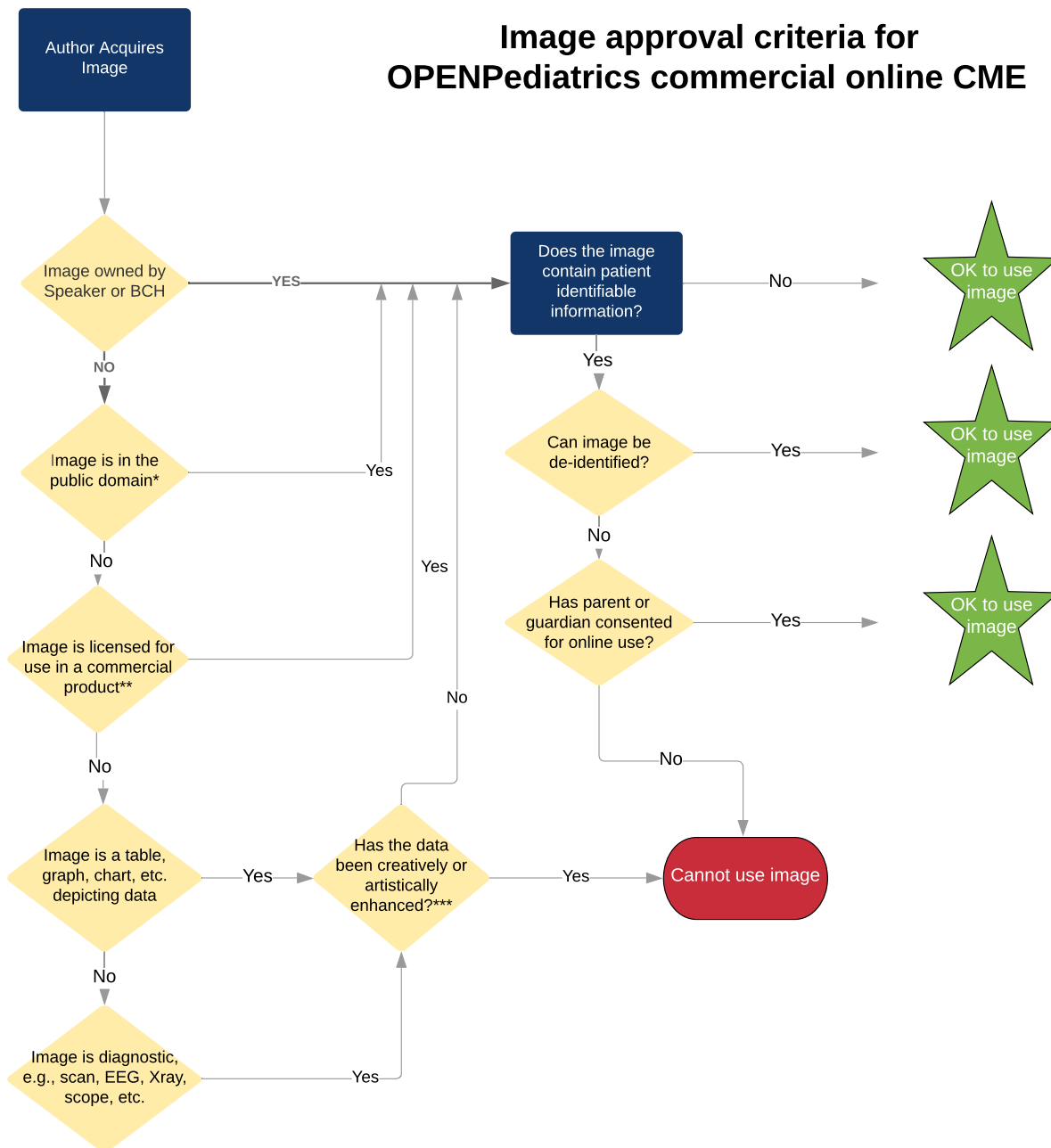


Image approval criteria for OPENPediatrics commercial online CME



*** Images MAY be in the public domain if they were:**

- created by a government agency
- published in the US prior to 1923, and maybe after, depending on publication details

**** Commercial license may be granted by:**

- Free Creative Commons license
- Express written permission from copyright holder
- Paid license from publisher, copyright clearance center, or other

***** Creative or Artistic Enhancement:**

This is a subjective term, but the idea is that visual representations of data in and of themselves are not subject to copyright. A basic table, chart or graph, with basic color coding may be ok to use. Copyright kicks in when the visual data representations reflect significant added creative or artistic effort.
