Breakout Group One: Contrasting Cases

Compare the elements of 3 baby skin rashes. You don't need to use medical descriptors- just compare and contrast them.

Identify <u>one person in your breakout group who will report back</u> to the larger group on what features of RASH 1 were highlighted by comparing it to the other rashes.





Breakout Group Two: Prototypical Cases

Prototype what constitutes "Bad News" in pediatrics. Remember to include edge cases.

Identity <u>one person in your breakout group who will report back</u> to the larger group about what essential features of bad news were highlighted through prototypical cases. Sharing can occur in the form of "I used to think..., but now I think...." or your group representative can share which cases prompted new thinking about bad news.
